

K-2 Pressure and Timeline Explanation

Defense can be played when:

- 1) Any part of the body of the player dribbling the ball up court crosses the geometric plane of the modified timeline, or the ball itself crosses the plane
- 2) During a pass, when the ball leaves the hand of the player bringing the ball to the front court and crosses the modified timeline towards receiver

10 Second Rule: Ten Second rule is modified from UIL rules to include the modified K-2 timeline

- 1) Official will count off ten seconds and signal an offensive turnover if the ball is not moved forward of the modified timeline within 10 seconds
- 2) Note- once ball or player initially crosses modified timeline (as mentioned above), there is no “protected zone”. Defense can be played as would normally be played.
